#### How to Get Here:

# By Train:

London Bridge is the nearest railway station and is five minutes' walk.

## By Tube:

- •London Bridge Northern and Jubilee lines (five minutes' walk)
- •Monument District and Circle lines (15 minutes' walk).

## By Bus:

The following buses stop at London Bridge, London Bridge station or near The Munro Centre:

- •17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141, 149, 343, 381, 521, 701, RV1, C10.
- •Night buses stop at or near London Bridge: N21, N35, N47, N133, N343 and N381.

Please note that there are no buses stopping along St Thomas Street (due to the redevelopment works at London Bridge station). All buses are now diverted to Dukes Street Hill. #### By Car:

The Munro Centre is located in the Congestion Charging zone and parking is very limited. Please use public transport whenever possible.

#### **Facilities:**

A Disabled toilet is located on the ground floor of the Munro Centre. There is a local Sainsbury's near the Southwark Wing.

## **Directions to the Munro Centre:**


From **London Bridge** Station (see overleaf) walk down Great Maze Pond, pass Guys Hospital to the end of the road. Then turn left onto Snowsfields Road. The Munro Centre is about 300 yards down on the left hand side of the road, the building opposite the NCP car park.

Upon arrival, press the buzzer 'Reception', and report to reception on the ground floor, where you will be invited to take a seat in the waiting area.
